Call for applications to teach in:**

Summer Session Term One (May to June 2022)
Summer Session Term Two (July to August 2022)
Winter Session Term One (September to December 2022)
Winter Session Term Two (January to April 2023)

The History Department invites applications to teach in the 2022 Summer Sessions and the 2022-2023 Winter Sessions. Applicants may apply for more than one session, and must specify which session(s) and term(s) they wish to teach. Preference will be given to applicants with a Ph.D. and experience in teaching at the college or university level, but applicants without a Ph.D. who are ABD will also be considered. The minimum salary for a 3-credit course in the Faculty of Arts is currently \$7,962.24.

Returning Applicants: those who have taught for us in the last five years, can simply

- a) Select History Department's course(s) on the online application form you are interested in teaching, including the session(s) and term(s) you wish to teach
- b) Upload an updated curriculum vitae

New Applicants: should provide the following application materials, and ask three referees to forward confidential letters of recommendation under separate cover to history.sessionals@ubc.ca.

- a) Select History Department's course(s) on the online application form you are interested in teaching, including the session(s) and term(s) you wish to teach
- b) Upload a curriculum vitae. The c.v. must include a list of post-secondary courses taught at UBC and elsewhere.
- c) And upload the following application materials (**in the following order, collated into a single PDF file**)
 - a letter of application, including a statement on experience and/or potential for teaching a diverse student population
 - one or more sample course outlines (from a course or courses you have taught or would be interested in teaching)
 - teaching evaluations
 - transcript of their academic record if they do not yet hold a Ph.D.
